

#### **CLASSROOMS**

- Classrooms will be set up to allow distance between students during classroom instruction.
- Teachers will avoid the use of shared materials and will have students use personal materials.
- Shared technology will be sanitized prior to use.
- Proper hand-washing, spacing, and precautions will be taught to students to ensure that students understand new routines and precautions.
- Teachers will wear masks when working with individual students, when unable to keep distanced from students, and when in transition.



### **HALLWAYS**

- · Students in grades K-4 will be taught procedures for walking in line to maintain spacing between students.
- Classes will use outside routes to locations as much as possible to avoid congestion in the hallways.
- Students in grades 5-6 will wear masks in the hallways during transitions due to the use of lockers and closer proximity during class changes.
- They will also sanitize hands during class changes before entering a new class.



#### **RECESS**

- Students will wash their hands prior to going to the playground and will wash their hands upon leaving the playground.
- No more than one grade level will be on the playground at one time.
- Students will be taught procedures for maintaining distance while playing on the playground.
- Limited shared playground toys (balls, games, etc) will be used during this time.



### LUNCH

- Students will be required to clean hands before entering the cafeteria and will also clean hands as they exit the cafeteria.
- Students will only sit with their homeroom of students to avoid contact with other classes.
- The cafeteria has created new procedures to prevent students from touching items other than their own when going through the line.
- Any grade that orders salad or soup in K-6 will be provided with a box salad or prepackaged soup.
- Thorough sanitation of tables will happen between classes.



## **ENRICHMENT**

- Students in grades K-6 will still participate in special areas/elective classes with proper precautions taken to protect students.
- All special area classes have detailed plans to ensure social distancing, avoiding shared materials, sanitation of spaces, and other procedures that will continue to protect our students.



# **FIELD TRIPS**

- No field trips off campus for K-6 will be scheduled during the first semester of the school year.
- We will reevaluate in December to make determinations about the second semester safety in taking field trips off campus.



## **ARRIVAL**

- All students in grades K-6 will follow their normal morning entry routine which allows students to enter through different entrances at staggered times.
- Upon arrival students will be guided to sanititize hands, plans are in place for distancing, and students will be separated by grade level to avoid contact with large groups of students.
- No students should enter through the front door of the building at this time.



### **DISMISSAL**

- K-1st will dismiss at 2:55pm from the side dismissal line (see carline map shared in coming days) and will remain distanced in their classrooms until their name is called for dismissal.
- 2nd-4th will dismiss from the back carline at 3:00pm (see carline map shared in coming days) and will sit outside with appropriate distance.
- 5th-6th will dismiss at 3:15pm from the back carline and will be sitting outside with appropriate distance.
